Rules and Regulations for the Columbarium

Appendix A

These rules and regulations are addressed to the 43 niche units donated by Koppenburg Enterprises, Inc. These niches are reserved for the victims of the Oso Landslide that occurred on March 22, 2014.

- A. Hereby reserved and restricted for the internment of persons deceased as a result of the Oso Landslide are forty-three (43) niches located in the Columbarium. These niches are reserved and restricted for a two (2) year period effective June 10th, 2015. Within that two (2) year period from the effective date a family member or authorized representative of the slide victim must notify the Town of Darrington in writing that they claim the niche on behalf of the slide victim.
- B. If after the two (2) year period has ended and, if a family member or an authorized representative does not claim the niche they will forfeit their rights to the niche and it will be surrendered to the Town of Darrington. The niche may not be "sold" back to the Town of Darrington.
- C. Any costs of inurnment such as engraving, markers, niche vases, opening and closing costs or any other costs associated with burial fees shall be the responsibility of the family member or authorized representative.
- D. The columbarium niche can hold up to three (3) urns depending upon the size of the urns. The dimensions of the niches are 10° W x 19^{3} 4"D x 14^{3} 4" H.
- E. If an authorized representative or family member opts to give a niche to a family member or other person(s), a notarized written document (Permission to Inter) must be submitted to the Town of Darrington on behalf of the slide victim.

F.	All authorized representatives or family member of the forty-three (43) victims, must also follow the Town of Darrington Cemetery Rules and Regulations that are established with
	the Town of Darrington.
