**Garbage Fee (per vehicle)**

360 lbs. or less = \$20, includes tax (minimum fee)

Over 360 lbs. = \$105 per ton, plus tax

(Fees are pro-rated for loads less than a ton)

**Accepted Household Hazardous Waste Products**

The following items are accepted at the County’s Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Station:

Acids, Aerosol Spray Cans, *Antifreeze\**, *Batteries\**, Bleach, Brake Fluid, Chemistry Sets, *Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs\**, Cooking Oil, Drain Cleaners, Dyes, Fertilizers, *Fire Extinguishers\**, Flammable Liquids, Floor Wax, *Fluorescent Tubes/Bulbs\**, Fungicides, Furniture Polish, Fusee / Road Flares, Gasoline / Diesel, Glues, Herbicides, Hydraulic Fluid, Insecticides, Kerosene & Kerosene-filled Heaters, Lamp Ballasts (unstamped/pre-1975), Lead, Mercury, Mildew Removers, Moth Balls, *Motor Oil\**, Neon Lights, *Oil Filters\**, Oven Cleaners, Paint, Varnish or Stains (Oil-based), [Paint, Latex \(for a fee\)](#), Paint Thinner, Pesticides, Photographic Chemicals, Pool Chemicals, *Propane Tanks\** (*BBQ size or smaller*), Rug and Upholstery Cleaners, Shoe or Silver Polish, Smoke Detectors, Solvents, Switches containing Mercury, Tar / Roofing Tar, Thermometers or Thermostats containing Mercury, Transmission Fluid, Ultraviolet Light Tubes, Wood Preservatives, X-Ray Film

\*These items are also accepted at our Recycling and Transfer Stations and Drop Box sites. Some quantity limits or other restrictions may apply.

**Prohibited Hazardous Waste Products**

The following items are not accepted at the county's Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Station:

Asbestos, Electronics, Empty Containers, Explosives (Call Local PD), Medical Waste, Medicine / Pharmaceuticals, Microwave Ovens, Non-hazardous Materials, Refrigerators / Freezers

Business / Commercial: Call for fees and appointment (425-388-6050)

**Unsecured Load Fee**

ALL loads arriving at any county Solid Waste facility must be covered and secured. A fee will be assessed for loads that are not properly covered with a tarp or net and secured with rope, bungee cords, netting or straps.

\$5 = Vehicles under 8,000 lbs

\$10= Vehicles 8,000 lbs or more

## **SOLID WASTE RATE SCHEDULE**

### **GENERAL WASTE**

#### **COMMERCIAL / RESIDENTIAL**

**(NON-EXEMPT)** - \$99.00 / ton

*Washington State Refuse Tax of 3.6% will be added to Non-Exempt rates*

**MINIMUM CHARGE** - \$16.00 | 300 pounds

**WHITE GOODS (APPLIANCES)** *-(Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, water coolers, humidifiers, etc.)* - \$25 each

*(Washing machines, dryers, stoves, hot water tanks, etc.)* - \$10 each

**TIRES** *(Only passenger car and light truck tires are accepted, must be separated)*

*Limit of 4 tires per load* - Charged at General Waste Rate.

### **MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED AT SKAGIT COUNTY DISPOSAL SITES**

#### **PETROLEUM CONTAMINATED SOILS**

**GREASE** - *food preparation wastes*

#### **ASBESTOS CONTAINING MATERIALS**

#### **CATALYST**

#### **SOD, SEEDS, BULBS, OR SAWDUST**

#### **HAZARDOUS, LIQUID, OR CHEMICAL WASTES**

### **MODERATE RISK WASTE**

*Only Moderate Risk Waste from qualifying Small Quantity Generators is accepted.*

*All materials will be charged by container size, rounded up to 1-gallon increments.*

**FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS (SOLVENTS)** - \$3.00/gallon

**FLAMMABLE LIQUID AEROSOLS** - \$1.00/Aerosol

**OIL-BASED PAINTS** - \$4.00/gallon

**PESTICIDE AEROSOLS** - \$3.00/ Aerosol

**PESTICIDES & POISONS** - \$16.00/gallon

**CORROSIVE MATERIAL** - \$18.00/gallon

**REACTIVE MATERIAL** – - \$38.00/gallon

*(Includes Dangerous When Wet, Spontaneously Combustible, and Flammable Solid categories. Reactives will be accepted only on a case-by-case basis, as decided by the Hazardous Waste Specialist.)*

**MOTOR OIL** – (Uncontaminated) - \$0.50/gallon

**MERCURY-CONTAINING LAMPS**

**FLORESCENT LAMPS** - \$0.10 / linear foot

**COMPACT FLORESCENT LAMPS** - \$0.50 / bulb

**HID LAMPS** - \$1.00 / lamp
