PUBLIC NOTICE

Town of Darrington 2021 Docket Public Hearing

The Town of Darrington will be holding a public hearing on the periodic review of the Town's Comprehensive Plan (Comp Plan) under RCW 36.70A.130(1)(a)). As part of the Legislative Review process, the Darrington Town Council will consider pursuing proposed changes to the Comp Plan or Future Land Use Map (FLUM), and will decide whether to refer the proposed changes to the Darrington Planning Commission for consideration as part of the 2021 Docket, or to defer the proposed changes to the 2023 Comp Plan Update, the next required update by state law, pursuant to DMC 17.80.060(2)(c). Comprehensive Plan Amendments, including amendments to the Future Land Use Map (FLUM) are an annual legislative decision and are not subject to the requirements of DMC 17.104 to DMC 17.116 per DMC 17.80.010.

- The Town Council will hold a public hearing set for **Wednesday March 10, 2021** at 7:00 pm at the Darrington Town Hall Council Chambers, 1005 Cascade Street.

Applicant Pugh Ridge Reload, LLC has submitted an application for a Comprehensive Plan Amendment proposing to change the Comprehensive Plan designation of 3 adjacent parcels along the southern Town Boundary located west of the Mountain Loop Highway that are currently designated Light Industrial/Manufacturing and zoned Light Industrial to Single Family Residential. They are surrounded by Single Family zoning to the south, west and north, and Light Industrial zoning to the east.
