

Garbage

Bag all trash and put in your **gray** cart.

Non-recyclable plastic

Foam containers and packing materials, caps, lids, stretch wrap, empty motor oil and antifreeze containers, plastic bakery and meat trays, plastic plates and utensils, empty prescription vials, garden hoses, disposable diapers and ribbons.



Non-recyclable paper

Disposable wipes, hardcover books, foil wrapping paper, dirty paper, facial tissue.



Non-recyclable glass

Mirrors, window glass, ceramics, dishes, incandescent and halogen light bulbs only.



Non-recyclable metal

Caps, lids, oil containers, hardened latex paint in cans (*remove lids*), sharp or greasy metal, clothes hangers, small non-working plastic appliances (*toasters, microwaves, coffee makers, etc.*)



TIP: Use kitty litter or paint hardener to solidify latex paint.

Garbage Guidelines

Charges are based on container size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.

- **Bag all garbage.**
- **Double bag pet litter, packing pellets and cold ashes.**

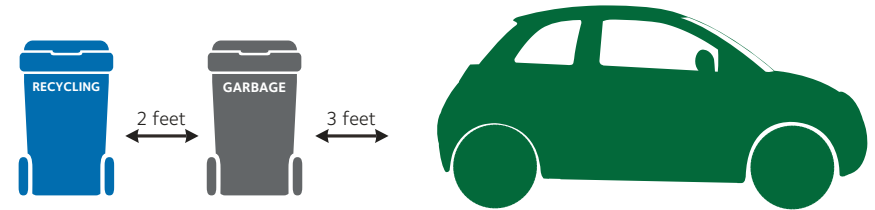

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

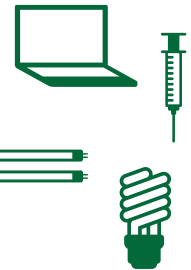


Place recycling and garbage containers at the curb by 6am at least two feet from other containers and three feet from cars or other objects.

Recycling is collected every other week. Garbage is collected weekly.

Hazardous and medical wastes

Fluorescent bulbs and tubes, needles, liquids, fuel tanks, computers and TVs are not allowed in garbage or recycling.

HOW TO PREPARE: RINSE CLEAN
EMPTY OF ALL FOOD AND LIQUIDS
FLATTEN CARDBOARD

DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES
PLACE LOOSE IN CART

Clean paper and cardboard

Mail, envelopes, newspaper, flattened cardboard, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper boxes (cereal, etc.), gift wrap (no foil or ribbon), and egg cartons.



Clean glass

Glass bottles and jars
Remove caps and lids



Recycle Right!
Contamination charges may be applied to improperly prepared recyclables.

Clean plastic

Plastic cups, plastic bottles, jugs, dairy tubs – Caps and lids go in the trash.



Clean metal cans

Aluminum and tin cans

Please place containers at the curb by 6:00 a.m.

- Two (2) feet apart with lids opening toward street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes
- Wheels as close to the curb as possible

Please remove containers as soon as possible after collection.

Recycling is collected every other week.

Garbage is collected weekly from subscribers.

Holiday Schedule: If collection day falls on a weekday on or after Thanksgiving (Nov 25), Christmas (Dec 25), or New Year (Jan 1), collection will be one day later that week (Friday customers will be picked up on Saturday).
