## Topics of discussion:

Purchases by Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe: Townsend Estates, Candle Shop and adjacent lot, Burger Barn

- Purchase of Townsend Estates will not displace any current tenants. Will be replacing trailers over the next 8 years, and adding additional trailers. They will replace and repair fence bordering current trailer park.

The tribal council was informed of the need for demo permits, roofing permits and building permits for the placement of trailers.

- All properties will be cleaned up, remodeled and upgraded.
- Possibly building a car wash on the vacant lot on corner of Seeman and Emens Ave.
- The remodel and repair of the business known as Mountain Loop Country Store. Renaming of the business.
- The addition and remodel of the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe Youth Center adding swimming pool, weight work out room, computer room, hot tub and sauna. This center will be open to the town residents for a possible minimal fee.

The Mayor Dan Rankin, informed the Tribal Council of the progress of the DWIC CLT project, the expansion and development of the Darrington Municipal Airport.

The need for local housing was discussed.
